

How to get an Auth Code/ transfer code

1. Account log in can be done under the following link: <https://www.nic.ru/en/auth/login/>

2. Transfer can be initiated under the following link:

Important notes for the domain transfer mask in the NIC-D handle account:

- a. specify your telephone number (if you intend to get the Auth Code/ transfer code via SMS)
 - b. Specify the affected domain name. Here is the possibility to enter up to 10 domain names.
 - c. Specify how you want to get the Auth Code/ transfer code. You have 3 possibilities:
 - Obtain your Auth Code/ transfer code by visiting RU-CENTER office personally in Moscow
 - Get the Auth Code/ transfer code via SMS (please specify the telephone number under a.)
 - Obtain the Auth Code/ transfer code via email.
- If you chose “obtain the transfer code by email” email with the link (valid for 3 business days) will be sent to the registrant’s email address. After the link confirmation registrant will receive an Auth Code/ transfer code. This code will be required by a new registrar when receiving domain names.

Important: after you have filled out the transfer mask in the NIC-D handle account and submitted your request you will not be able to abort your request manually in the registrant account.

Example:

You have chosen the option to obtain your Auth code by visiting RU-CENTER office in Moscow by mistake. This request will stay active for 30 calendar days in the RU-CENTER database. Alternatively, you can contact RU-CENTER and ask to cancel your initial request. In this case, RU-CENTER team will abort your request manually and you will not have to wait for 30 calendar days in order to proceed with the domain transfer.

If a Registrant contacts RU-CENTER directly, he should use following email address: ru-ncc@nic.ru.

Please ensure to include customer authorisation details (NIC-D account number) in your request.
